

CHAPTER XII

Trade and Licensing

1. The Clerk, his deputy or such other person as Council shall appoint shall issue licenses under this By-Law upon payment of the fees prescribed in Section 7 of this By-Law.
2. (a) No person who is not a resident of the Municipality shall peddle, hawk or trade goods without first obtaining a license therefore which is in force under this By-Law.
(b) Any person may, without a license peddle, hawk or trade goods from door to door where the goods are products of the farm, the forest or the sea. No person who is not a resident or a rate payer of the Municipality shall carry on the business of a photographer or take or solicit orders for photographs or enlargements of photographs made by any process where there is to be consideration moving to such person for making or delivering such photograph unless he holds a license therefore which is in force under this By-Law.
3. No person who is not a resident of the Municipality shall on his own behalf or as an Agent of another, exercise within the Municipality the calling of a book agent or a magazine salesman or peddle, hawk, take orders for or otherwise deal in books or magazines without first having obtained a license

therefore. (see amendments Page

4. (1) No person shall act as auctioneer or carry on a calling or business of an auctioneer or sell at public auction any real estate, goods or chattels whatever by public auction within the Municipality without having first taken out a license therefore, which license shall be personal to the party to whom it is granted and shall entitle such person only to sell thereunder.
- (2) Every person who acts as an auctioneer or sells or attempts to sell any such property by public auction within the Municipality without having first obtained a license therefore shall in addition to the amount of the license fee be liable to a penalty not exceeding twenty dollars and in default of payment imprisonment for a period not exceeding ten days.

Travelling Shows 5.

No circus, managerie, travelling show or entertainment to which admission is obtained by the payment of money shall be offered to view, set up, maintained or carried on within the Municipality without a license (this Section subject to the provisions of the "the theatre, cinematographs and amusement act").

Junk Dealer

6. (i) No person shall carry on business as a dealer or other section hand materials without first having obtained a license under this By-Law.

- (ii) Every person who shall carry on business as a dealer in old metal or other second hand materials shall register his name and place of abode and every place of business, warehouse, store and place of deposit occupied or used by him for the purpose of such business in a book to be kept for that purpose at the office of the Clerk.
- (iii) Every person carrying on business as aforesaid shall correctly enter in a book to be kept by him for that purpose the description and price of all articles purchased or otherwise acquired by him and the name, address and occupation of the person from whom the same were purchased or otherwise required.
- (iv) Any peace officer shall have free access at all reasonable times to every such place of business, warehouse, store and place of deposit to inspect the same and the books by this Section required to be kept, and every person who shall prevent him or obstruct any such peace officer in the execution of his duties under this sub-section shall be liable to a penalty.
- (v) Every person carrying on business as aforesaid shall keep his place of deposit fenced in such a manner as to reasonably conceal the contents from public view.

Fees for 7.
Licenses

The Clerk shall issue licenses under this Section which shall be in force for the calendar year in which the same is taken out or issued upon payment of the fee as follows:

(a) Where the applicant is not a resident or ratepayer of the Municipality:

Auctioneer	\$20.00
Peddler, Hawker or Trader	50.00
Photographer, Canvasser, Solicitor or Agent	20.00
Magazine or Book Salesman	25.00
Junk Dealer	20.00

(b) There the applicant is a resident or a ratepayer in the Municipality:

Auctioneer	\$10.00
Junk Dealer	5.00
Other classifications	nil

8. Every licensee when engaged in his trade or calling shall display his license on the demand of any person.
9. Every licensee who is the holder of a salesman's, peddler's, hawker's, or trader's license shall display his name and the number of his license on his vehicle or pack.
10. The Clerk may replace any license on the payment of one dollar where he is satisfied the same has been lost, stolen or destroyed.
11. This chapter shall not apply to persons taking orders for delivery of goods at wholesale for the purpose of being sold at retail within the Municipality.

12. Nothing in this chapter shall apply to any Sheriff, Bailiff or other Officer of the Law under legal process or to any person selling at any social or benevolent entertainment.

 - (a) Where it appears to the license committee that it is necessary to do so, it may instruct the Clerk to cancel any license issued under the provisions of this By-Law.
 - (b) The Clerk shall notify the holder of such license of the cancellation by mailing a notice of cancellation to his last known place of operations.
 - (c) A license cancelled pursuant to the provisions of sub-section (a) and (b) of this Section shall cease to be in force two clear days after the date of mailing.
