The Lynyak property in Little River is the only remaining grand Victorian home left in the village. The property is a fine example of the prosperous shipping trade along the Digby Neck shoreline.

This home was built in 1910 by Captain Darryl Cheney, who moved to Little River from Grand Manan in 1909. He married a local woman named Gertrude Trask that same year.

Captain Cheney made his living as a fish merchant buying and selling fish to the United States Of America and Maritime markets. His wife and children spent many weeks at sea traveling with him from port to port.

The house stands today very much like it did 90 years ago; majestically along the road leading to St. Mary's Bay.
