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New Business

Review of Municipal Planning Strategy for the Regulation of Wind Turbine Development in the Municipality of the District of Digby Chris Millier reviewed the steps involved in the process of reviewing the Wind Turbine MPS & LUB. He indicated that he didn't expect any major changes to the MPS/LUB.

The Wind Turbine MPS is the Primary Strategy as it covers the entire municipality. The other Municipal Planning Strategies will become Secondary Strategies.
